PRICING

MON - THURS: \$120/ PLAYER + GST

The buffet dinner includes one serving per guest of EITHER roast beef OR lemon thyme chicken thighs, served with bread, a choice of EITHER Caesar OR green salad, roasted potatoes, and seasonal vegetables. Minimum of 30 guests required.

FRI-SUN & HOLIDAYS: \$145/PLAYER + GST

The buffet dinner includes one serving per guest of steak, served with bread, a choice of EITHER Caesar OR green salad, roasted potatoes, and seasonal vegetables. A minimum of 30 guests is required.

MEAL ADD-ONS

- Coffee \$3/player + GST
- Breakfast Sandwich \$8/player + GST
- Light Dessert Assortment \$3/player + GST

Additional services may be requested, with costs determined upon request. Prices are subject to 20% gratuity and GST.

TOURNAMENT SERVICES INCLUDE:

- On-site coordinators
- 18-hole round of golf with power carts
- Menu selection
- Personalized cart signs
- Beverage cart and snack service
- Private event facilities
- Set-up and on-course assistance
- Skill markers for on-course contests (proxies)
- Course marshal and player assistant

Additional services may be requested, with costs determined upon request.







POLICIES & REGULATIONS

DEPOSITS

- Deposts are required at time of booking to secure the date.
- Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable, and will be applied to the final tournament balance.

CANCELLATIONS

- Cancellations within 30 business days of the event will be charged the full estimated tournament fees.
- Tournaments will proceed regardless of the weather tournaments play rain or shine.
- If Cattail Crossing deems the course unplayable due to inclement weather or another act of God, the food and beverage department requires a minimum of 60 minutes to prepare the tournament meal.

SPEED OF PLAY / ETIQUETTE

- Golfers are expected to keep up with the group ahead of them.
- Course marshals will monitor slow play. Groups falling more than one hole behind will be asked to pick up their balls and catch up.
- For shotgun tournaments, the maximum round time is 5.5 hours.
- For tee time tournaments, the maximum round time is 4.5 hours.
- Players should be courteous to other golfers by raking bunkers, repairing ball marks and divots, and driving power carts responsibly.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

- All prices on the current price list are subject to change and will be confirmed no later than 60 days before the event.
- Any leftover food prepared by Cattail Crossing must remain on the premises.
- All outside food and beverage products must be approved in advance by Cattail Crossing. Failure to comply may result in additional charges.
- All perishable food must be handled according to Alberta Health regulations. Staff and volunteers should follow proper sanitation, food handling, and temperature controls.
- All outside food must include signage indicating it was provided by a third-party source or sponsor.
- Cattail Crossing is not liable for product quality, storage, or any damages caused by third-party products served on the property.









POLICIES & REGULATIONS

LIQUOR

- Cattail Crossing's liquor policy follows Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission guidelines.
- All alcohol must be purchased from Cattail Crossing. Any outside alcohol will be confiscated, and playing privileges may be revoked. This is a zero-tolerance policy.
- Tournaments wishing to host a liquor hole must purchase alcohol from Cattail Crossing. Hard liquor is sold by the bottle—consult with Event Coordinators for pricing.
- Drink tickets are available and will be charged based on the number of tickets printed.
- Cattail Crossing requires 14 days' notice for alcohol purchases for beverage holes.

DISCLAIMERS

- Each golfer is required to have a set of golf clubs.
- Any damage or lost equipment, including power carts, lost property, or property damage, will be charged to the tournament.
- Cattail Crossing is not responsible for any loss or injury suffered or incurred by guests.
- All signage, banners, and other materials must be removed after the event. Cattail Crossing is not responsible for any signage left behind after 72 hours.
- Modified shotgun starts are available from 72 players.
- Groups with fewer than 72 players will be offered tee times.
- Cattail Crossing reserves the right to allow other golfers on the course if your group does not book the entire course.
- Full course exclusivity requires payment for minimum 120 players' green fees.
- Cattail Crossing reserves the right to determine the placement of sponsors, food, and alcohol on the course.
- Start times may be adjusted if necessary.

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AGREEMENTS, ACKNOWLEDGMENTS & WHAT WE NEED FROM YOU!

To ensure your tournament day runs smoothly, the Cattail Crossing staff requires a few things from you, the tournament coordinator, in the lead-up to the event.

ON DEPOSIT

- Estimated number of players and dinner guests.
- Any special requests for your tournament (e.g., silent auction, non-standard format, etc.).
- The initial number of golfers must be within 25% of the actual number on the day of the tournament.
- (e.g., If you book for 100 players, the lowest final number allowed is 75. If your count drops below 75, you will still be charged for 75 players.)

14 DAYS PRIOR

- Updated number of players and dinner guests (you will be charged for a minimum of 90% of this number).
- Estimated number of rental sets required (subject to availability).
- Final numbers must be provided 14 days before the event, with a variance of +/- 10%.
- (e.g., If you booked for 100 golfers but have 90 confirmed, your final number can be between 81 & 99.)

7 DAYS PRIOR

- Final number of players and dinner quests (you will be charged for this number or the final number served, whichever is higher).
- Finalized roster for players and sponsors, inputted in the provided spreadsheet.
- Ensure each group has at least one experienced golfer, where possible.
- Summary of all sponsor advertising and event holes (e.g., food, drinks, contests). A template is provided in this package.
- Final numbers must be confirmed 7 days before the event.
- The tournament organizer will be charged for the guaranteed number or the actual number of guests whichever is higher.

48 HOURS PRIOR

- Any final edits to the roster (changes within 48 hours of the tournament may not be completed in
- Any sponsor signs/ PDFs can be dropped off at Cattail.
- Tournament format and rule sheet completed and submitted to Cattail.









AGREEMENTS, ACKNOWLEDGMENTS & WHAT WE NEED FROM YOU!

DAY OF EVENT

- As the tournament coordinator, your only job on tournament day is to check in your guests!
- An invoice for the final event cost will be sent to you.

A FEW THINGS TO NOTE

- Every golfer is required to have their own set of golf clubs. Rental sets are available for individuals or tournaments
- If more than 10 rental sets are needed, please notify Cattail Crossing at least 14 days in advance.
- Cattail Crossing provides up to 72 power carts for events. If additional carts are needed (e.g., for volunteers or sponsors), a minimum of 14 days' notice is required. Additional fees will apply.
- Any golfer not abiding by Cattail Crossing's rules and regulations may be asked to leave.
